Minutes

January 20, 2010

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

DPL Hockey Head coach Brian Loeck (Lake) introduced himself.

Minutes: The minutes from the December Meeting were reviewed, Buck made motion to approve and Nan seconded and the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Lori read the report:

Athletic Director's Corner: Georgia: Curling – Boys - Portage, Curling – Girls – Home, Boys BB – Columbus, Girls BB – Lake Mills, Wrestling – Lodi, Hockey – Monona Grove.

Georgia reported the new logo was printed and would be available for school sponsored items. Josten's created the logo and an agreement between Josten's and the school prohibits giving the logo to anyone who sells class rings. The logo currently does not have any colors, but the P will be Orange and the Puma will be Tawny or Black. The middle school girls basketball team is having t-shirts made with the new logo. Bob O raised concern that by giving the logo out the Booster Club was losing money since the teams were getting shirts made without going through the Booster Club. The logo will not carry a trademark as Mr. McCallum is not interested in getting a trademark for the logo. There will be a question as to who would enforce the trademark of the logo if one were obtained.

Old Business

Clothing: We still have Puma clothing which was sold at Homecoming Pep Rally available for sale. Sweatshirt (no XL) black and orange, T-shirts; Georgia is going to check on the logo.

Basketball Raffle: Basketball Raffle is ready to go.

DPL Hockey Request: Coach Brian Loeck reported there are currently 26 students playing on the DPL Hockey team – breakdown of students between schools is pretty even – 8 or 9 from DeForest, 6 from Lodi and 6 from Poynette. Current record is 5 -7-2 and play in the Badger North Conference. There are 13 or 14 games for the J.V. Varsity will play Monona Grove this Friday – January 22. Brian requested a check for \$50 per player to help with the costs for each player. The check amount was amended to \$300 to DeForest Norski Blueline Hockey Club. Brian also made mention a new Rink was being built in Waunakee and hopes it will help cut costs. He is working on other ways to cut the costs for the players.

There is a two week lead time once the curtains are ordered. Getting from same company bleachers were purchased from. Buck made motion and Steve seconded, motion carried.

Street Dance/Fireworks: The date is set – July 17th. Will need people to work the street dance the following night. We will have a better location than last year. This is money in our pockets – last year we made \$8 or \$900.

Tiles: Nan reported that Brian Lair does not want to install the tiles, but is willing to train a replacement.

Buck motioned to adjourn and Lori seconded and the motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
