Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes from the October Meeting were reviewed and there was an error. Under the Exercise Bike Repairs it indicated Bob T. brought up that a few of the bikes were broken when in fact it was Bob O. Davy made the first motion to amend approve and Lissa seconded and the motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Lori read report

Laurie J. made a motion to accept, Davy seconded and the motion carried.

Athletic Director's Corner: Georgia - Boys basketball Nov. 23rd scrimmage, Girls basketball Dec. 1st Portage game, Wrestling Dec. 5th Nan K. added Hockey starts this weekend.

Old Business:

- **Clothing:** Embroidered versus Screen printing, Jostens doing mascot computerized stay where at for ordering.
- **Hockey:** 5:00 am practices, need something written from coach to donate money. \$50/per player.

New Business:

- **Display Cases:** Dan Branton presented proposal for display cases. Floor to ceiling- 8 ft. tall by 6 ft. wide can move, 1/3 of cost to go to ceiling (wasted space-same as currently out there). Bottom would be used for storage, with sliding doors, 2 feet deep pitch bottom and add hangars for clothing. Approximately \$250 per section. Bob O. is getting price on glass (tempered). You would be able to lock. Georgia asked about putting boards on top of older part. Put flat plaques with hangers in there to display versus laying flat. It was mentioned that a lot of the old trophies are in storage at the Historical Society. Amy Bruchs mentioned that in Marshall and/or Belleville they have plaques bolted to the wall (can't steal) on the cabinet face-above cabinet. Discussed moving thermostat to run power and lights in from the top. Dan mentioned assembling off site and bringing in and bolting to the wall. They could be pulled apart later. Is glass as expensive as mirrors? Is this a group project? It was suggested Dan build one-prototype and to get started for everyone to see. Cheryl

Ray motioned to go ahead and Lori K. seconded. Ben Kreyer mentioned he could get plexiglass to cover the plaques and protect them from touching and scratching.

- **Website**: Davy asked about the fee it is approximately \$300. "PoynetteABC.org" is the Booster Club website. Currently, there isn't a link to the the new school website. Davy and Georgia discussed getting the link set up to the Athletic website.
- **Tiles**: Nan had a bill
- **Raffle**: Laurie Jenson presented a basketball fundraiser idea. She called it VIP Puma Fun. Sell tickets for \$5.00 for two people at each home game to receive a meal, 2 reserve center court seats, 1 reserve parking space, and a photo with the Puma mascot. Discussed having signs made, orange cones in the parking spot. Discussed raffle license. Other schools doing this for community support, one school had recliners for the reserved seats. Georgia was going to check into could get students involved with the Art class, Photo club, valet parking. Amy Bruchs indicated there is a \$25.00 annual fee for a raffle license and your gross receipts need to be less than \$50,000. Could also get players autographs and sell the tickets before. The winner would be announced at the home prior to the game they would be VIP. See attached.
- **Appreciation Night**: Girls basketball is Feb. 11 and Boys basketball is Feb. 12, Parents bring baked goods/juice for after the games in the cafeteria. Youth appreciation night not confirmed yet.
- **Football fundraiser/Raffle**: Football coaches are preparing lasagna for the 11 Seniors. The Senior parents donated \$150.
- **Basketball Fundraiser/Raffle**: It was mentioned that the basketball coaches cook and do this as well.

Davy motioned to adjourn and Llssa seconded and the motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
