MINUTES

October 21, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes from the September meeting were reviewed. Davy motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Nan seconded and the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Lori read report. Buck motioned to approve report, seconded by Cheryl R and the motion carried.

Athletic Director's Corner: Jay Hausser reported that the Girls Cross Country placed 3rd at Capital Conference Meet, Katie Wasserburger was 1st Team, and Katie Severson & Tori Ruf were 2nd Team. Boys Cross Country placed 2nd at Capital Conference Meet, Brett Severson was 1st Team and Trevor Moen was 2nd Team. Soccer finished 8-12-1 for the season. Football finished the regular season at 6-2 and will play against Pardeeville in the playoffs Tuesday, October 27. Volleyball finished the season 1 – 9.

- **Mascot:** The Varsity Club decided to pay \$1,530 for "Tawny" Puma costume. A second Puma costume has been ordered in black for \$1,530. Dean moved to help with the cost of the second costume, seconded by Lissa S and the motion carried. Jay noted having two costumes would allow "The Puma" mascot to participate at more sporting/extra curricular activities. Younger students are going to be instructed on "Puma" costume etiquette, such as not pulling the tail or hitting the mascot. The student who is selected to wear the costume has been instructed not to remove the head or speak, fans can have their picture taken with "Puma".
- **Homecoming:** Bob O reported \$786 was made from the sale of food at the tailgate party, for a total of \$300 net. Sod and other items left over from the street dance contributed to the total net sales.
- **Exercise Bike Repairs:** Bob T brought up they had a few exercise bikes that were broken and could be refurbished at a cost of \$150-\$200 per bike. Greg motioned to pay for the repairs, seconded by Ann Rice and the motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

- **Highlight Video:** Money is still being raised through company sponsors however they are still going to be short. Bob offered to donate \$5 from the sale of the NFL raffle tickets sold by

“football parents” a total of \$995 would make up the difference they are short for the Football Highlights Video.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cheryl made a motion to pay \$52.53 for the purchase of the socks and dye, seconded by Ben K and the motion carried.
- **DPL Hockey Program:** A request was made to donate \$50 per Poynette player for the 2009-2010 DPL Hockey program. We have 5 students who are playing hockey this year. Bob T made a motion to donate \$50 per Poynette player, seconded by Greg S and motion carried.
- **Any other new business:** None at this time.
