

# POYNETTE ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB

Minutes  
September 10, 2008

Meeting called to order at 7:02 p.m.

New attendees introduced themselves.

**Minutes:** The minutes from the July meeting were reviewed. Cheryl R. corrected the minutes about the “post party” after the homecoming game is not well attended. Davy motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Gregg seconded and the motion carried.

**Treasurer’s Report:** Lori K. gave the report for August. Total August meeting checking balance was \$5,522.60. Total deposits made since the last meeting was \$7,325.00. Total payments made were \$1,029.41. Total checkbook balance as of September 10th is \$12,003.19. Total CD value is \$5,637.43. Balance all is \$17,640.62. Some issues were discussed about the agility money. Joann motioned to approve the treasurer report, Buck seconded and the motion carried.

**Athletic Director’s Corner:** Georgia was not present, Bob read her report. The programs put out by the Booster Club turned out great, thank you for a positive manner in athletics. Facilities meeting tonight at 6:30. Next week Homecoming activities are as follows: Monday – JV football game cancelled. Junior vs. Senior Girls football game will be at 6:00. Thursday – Parade will follow the volleyball games, approximately 7:15. The PEP Rally will follow the parade, approximately 7:45-8:00 start time. Friday – Booster Club tailgate and football game. Saturday – Homecoming Dance @8-midnight.

## OLD BUSINESS:

- **Weight Room Remodel:** Some equipment still needs to be moved in – tread mill, stationary bike need to figure out where to put it. No mirrors are up yet.
- **Aluminum Can Drive:** Bob talked with Guy Senkowski (Poynette Ironworks). He will make us a bin for the cans, paint it and take it to Piggly Wiggly for us. Bill has called Keith’s Recycling, but has not heard back yet.
- **NFL Raffle:** Total count of tickets sold is 290 out of 650. Every community is way down on ticket sales this year. It was motioned to draw out 2 tickets from our local sales and give the winners each \$10.00. Gregg motioned to approve the drawing, seconded by Sue and the motion carried. We will draw the tickets at the next Booster Club meeting.
- **Homecoming Tailgate:** Need coolers and tables. Set up starts at 3:30, tailgate starts at 5:00 and ends at 6:30. Any good ideas for getting free gifts to raffle. Some same things will be used as far as coaches giving signed sports

paraphernalia. A lot of members are getting things from previous donators. Any leftover food will be donated to the Haunted House workers on Saturday. Gregg and Joann will drive the gator in the parade doing advertising for the haunted house and Booster Club.

- **Haunted House:** We can start putting it up on September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Davy is checking into to it to make sure. The contract with Tom has not been signed yet. 50/50 is what it was last year. Bob is meeting with Tom to discuss issues and concerns before signing the contract. Tom is interviewing with the Poynette Press and talking with some clubs at the school for helpers. The new dates that the haunted house will be running are October 11th being opening night, then the 18<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, and November 1<sup>st</sup>. It will be about 3200 square feet, 9-10 rooms obviously smaller than last year. Tom will have some sort of plan drawn out before we get started. Main concern first is making sure the structure is secured. The Park Board would like banners up so that people know what is being worked on so they don't call the village asking questions. Possibly using small building where mower is kept for a dressing room. Davy is checking out what time we need to be out of the park by.
- **Any other old business:** A letter needs to be regenerated for the coaches for their wish list. Cheryl H. will update that letter and e-mail it to Jodi. Dekorra Fireworks parking donation was \$1,000.00.

- **Any other new business:** Elections are as follows for new positions: Bob O. is President, motioned by Paul, seconded by Cheryl H. – Treasurer is Lori K., motioned by Cheryl R., seconded by Cheryl H. – Directors are Cheryl H. and Cheryl R., motioned by Lori, seconded by Kristine. Cheryl H. mentioned that next summer is the Garden Tour if any clubs are interested.

Gregg motioned to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Davy.
