

POYNETTE ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB  
Minutes  
August 15, 2007

Meeting called to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Minutes:** The minutes from the July meeting were reviewed. Gregg motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Tom seconded and the motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Jeanne gave the report for July. Total July meeting checking account balance \$12,720.50. Total deposits made since last meeting \$460.00. Total payments made since last meeting \$3,950.30. Total checking account balance from statement since last meeting \$9,230.20. Total CD value \$10,236.85. Net balance all \$19,467.05. Tom motioned to approve report, seconded by Buck and the motion carried.

**Athletic Director's Corner:** The Poynette/Portage Soccer Co-Op began this week. Numbers are low, so most likely there will be no J.V. team. Dave Presser is the new coach for the Boys Soccer Team replacing Karin Williams. The North Division banners are ready to be put up in the new gym. Homecoming Football game is Friday, September 28<sup>th</sup>. Doug had alerted WLP's AD about this and made mention of the usual Homecoming Tailgate. Doug will send a formal invite to them in the next few weeks. The tentative date for the Press box Dedication is September 14<sup>th</sup>-first Varsity Football game vs. Lake Mills. It is also Parent's Night. Senior Night will be the last game of the season vs. Marshall. They are still looking for a Head Track Coach. The Freshmen Girls Basketball position is still available, but they do have some interested candidates for that one. Due to scheduling issues, the Poynette Cross Country Invite will be held on Friday, September 7<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 pm at the Pauquette Pines Golf Course. Varsity Football is away that night at New Glarus/Monticello. Also, it was mentioned that on October 5<sup>th</sup> would be a recognition night for Steve A., the former student athletic trainer.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- Press Box: Thanks to some very dedicated hard workers the press box is coming along good☺ Gregg is contacting Alliant Energy to get the holes dug. We have spent approximately \$26,386.00 so far. More bills are trickling in. Budgeted for approximately \$40,000.00
- Scoreboard: It is scheduled to be here next week.
- MDA Ride: We made \$200.00 working the booth at the MDA Ride. We were anticipating a lot more due to the facts we were given about the

ride. Apparently Sauk had food booths set up; therefore not everyone ate at the Poynette booths.

- NFL Raffle: Keep turning in tickets sales. We would like all turned in right after Labor Day.
- Tailgate Party: There is a sign up sheet going around. Price is staying the same at \$5.00/Adult and \$2.00 /Students. Any raffle ideas, let Bob know.

  - b. Post game party: Last year it was at Lockwood's Longshot. Everyone seemed to be pleased. Gregg motioned to have it there again this year, seconded by Dan and motion carried.
  - c. Advertising: Jodi is checking with Sue about banner. She is also putting it in the Poynette Press.
- Program Sponsors: Jodi sent out a letter to local businesses again for their advertising on the athletic programs. We are trying to get it done by the first home Conference Volleyball Match on September 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Any other old business: None at this time.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Dance Team: Doug received an e-mail from the Dance Team requesting a donation to help them go to Camp Randall for the Football Game. It was motioned to donate \$35.00 by Gregg and seconded by Tom and the motion carried.
- Senior Parent Highlight Video: Karla asked for a donation of what we spent last year for the highlight video. It was motioned by Nan that \$100.00 be given, seconded by Tom and motion carried.
- Fund Raising Issues: Bob wants to know why it seems that when he would ask for some kind of fund raising by the Booster Club that is would always get turned down. Doug is checking in to finding out how things are getting approved. What is not known whether or not all of the clubs are getting approval, or are they just doing it since in the past it had been done?
- Dekorrra Fireworks: Tim, who is in charge of the Dekorrra Fireworks that they display every mid-summer, would like to know if the Booster Club

would have about 10 to 15 volunteers to help park cars. It is growing every year and they really could use the help. We could profit around \$1,000.00. It is going to be held July 19<sup>th</sup> of 2008. You would start between 3:00-4:00 pm and get done around one hour after the fireworks display were done. Something to consider.

- Hockey: Paul asked for a donation for the Hockey Ad. There are 4 Poynette participants this year. Karla motioned to give the \$125.00 to place the ad, seconded by Cheryl and motion carried.
- Any other new business: Jeanne Gill would like to step down from her position as Treasurer. We need a replacement A.S.A.P.
