- *Scholarships:* Two - \$300 scholarships will be given out from the Booster Club. One boy and one girl.
- *Mascot Issues:* Booster Club as a group needs to decide together what our opinion is and present it to the school board. If we want to keep the logo, we need a letter proving there is no negative impact.
