Meeting called to order at 7:05 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Press Box: The Chamber of Commerce voted to make a \$5,000 donation stating that we should challenge the community to donate money and they would match that amount up to \$5,000. Bob feels we should run this through Barb. Bob will talk to the Poynette Press about writing an article.
- N.F.L. Raffle: The tickets are here. No changes made. Twenty dollars per ticket.
- Sportsmanship and School Song Signs: As mentioned above, they should be done some time in July. They are still looking for a donation from PABC. The Board approved changes to the school song.
- Haunted House: Gregg spoke with Lakeside Foods and they have a building we may possible rent for \$1,200 a year. We could leave everything set up just as it is. - Coaches Wish List: They are looking at software (Hy-Tek Program) for track from their monies from the pancake breakfast. Tom will talk with Craig. The new AD should address the coaches about the wish list.

- Board Members (President, Treasurer, 2 Directors): President Bob Odegaard and Treasurer Jeanne Gill will remain in their current positions. A big thanks you to both of you. We only need one director's seat to fill.

NEW BUSINESS:

- We received thank you cards from Ryan Scherneck for the scholarship, Jenny Cross for all our support and help with track, and Dana Breed for the gifts given to her for her resignation from the AD position.
- There will be a new pharmacy opening in Poynette run by the people at Rio's pharmacy. Jodi has talked to them about possibly displaying our clothing there.
- Anthony Mabrey asked for a donation for the All-Star Baseball game he will be participating in. Bob motioned \$125, seconded by Joann and motioned carried.
- The student council has dealt with the mascot name change for a long time. Tom suggested that they should ask the students. A big percentage does not want to change. With the students voting on this situation, the student council does not take the heat for the decision made.

Tom motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jodi.
