Minutes
November 19, 2008

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes from the October meeting were reviewed. Gregg motioned to approved the minutes as submitted, Buck seconded and the motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Lori K. gave the report for October. Total October meeting checking balance was \$10,328.58. Total deposits made since the last meeting was \$11,733.13. Total payments were made \$4580.65. Total checkbook balance as of November 18 is \$17,481.06. Total CD value is \$5,637.43. Balance all is \$23,118.49. Some haunted house receipts are still outstanding. Piggly Wiggly bill needs to be paid and is approximately \$200. Gregg motioned to approve the treasure report, Davy seconded. MSC.

Athletic Director: Not present. *Note to self: put Georgia on the email list.* Girls' basketball games start tomorrow night. Boys' basketball starts in December.

A thank you was passed around from the dance team for the \$100 for new poms. Barb Wolfe made a \$50 donation to the Haunted House in lieu of acting/participating.

Old Business:

***Weight Room Remodel:** Remodel in progress. Mirror brackets are very costly. Will be approximately \$300 worth of track. Display boards may be updated and put on the hall by the track boards to display other boards that are currently in the weight room. To get matching boards with the track boards, the cost is approx \$600 with plaques, engraving, etc. Bob O. will be checking into details. Cost may be around \$2400 to have boards put up.

*Haunted House Discussion:

- Haunted House: Earned \$9970 from admissions. There was a village fee of \$25. Bob suggested the Booster Club make an additional donation to the village. \$2562 in bills for the Haunted House. \$7408 profit as of now. Actors' meals were \$300. Concession stand brought in some money. Tom still needs to be paid.
- MSC Gregg S./Cheryl H. to give \$225 to village for use of the shelter. Old warehouse is still rented with no payment.
- MSC DavyT./Cheryl R. to pay \$1000 for rent for the warehouse for the past two years.
- Hayride at Mackenzie was scheduled during some of the same nights. This was not meant to be a competition for people and we want to make it beneficial for both organizations. Bob O. will go to Friends of Mackenzie next meeting to see how we can work cooperatively.
- Suggestions for Haunted House 2009: Set up a committee of 11 people putting a person in charge of each room. Bring ideas to PABC. Suggestion was made to solo on future Haunted House now that we have experience.

New Business:

- Wrestling mat platform will be needed in February. We will be the recipient of mats and they will need to be stored so we need to make a platform.
- Basketball fan appreciation is scheduled; MSC Buck W./Cheryl H. to have Girls' Basketball Fan Appreciation Night on Thursday, January 29, Boys' Fan Appreciation Night on Friday, January 30th. Both games feature Columbus as the opponent.
