Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes from the August meeting were reviewed. Gregg motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Buck seconded and the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Jeanne gave the report for August. Total August meeting checking account balance \$9,230.30. Total deposits made since last meeting \$15,343.00. Total payments made since last meeting \$11,328.95. Total checking account balance from statement since last meeting \$13,244.35. Total CD value \$10,236.85. Net balance all \$23,481.20. Joann motioned to approve report, seconded by Karla and the motion carried.

Athletic Director's Corner: The North Division Banners are hung in the new gym. There will be a doubleheader tomorrow night. The Freshmen Football game vs. Lake Mills followed by the Varsity Soccer vs. Columbus. Due to parent/teacher conferences on October 4th, the Freshmen Football game scheduled against Water Luther Prep will be held on Wednesday, October 3rd. The Homecoming Football game is Friday, September 28th. The theme for the dance is "Glow with the Flow". Doug sent WLP's AD a formal invite to the Homecoming Tailgate. Powder Puff is scheduled for 9/26, the parade on 9/27 with the pep rally to follow. Steve Allison Appreciation Day and Press box dedication will be held on October 5th during the football game. There was a possibility that we were going to host the Capitol North Conference Track Meet; however Lodi will be hosting it now that they have a pole vault pit. As of now, we will host in the year 2012. Reminder of bleacher blankets: they can be placed on the bleachers beginning at 4:00 p.m. the day of the event for a game with a starting time of 7:00 p.m. If an event starts earlier than 7:00 p.m., you may place them no earlier than 3 hours prior to the start time.
