Meeting called to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Minutes:** The minutes from the March meeting were reviewed; a correction was made stating that the press box was changed from a 3 story to a 2 story. Davy motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Todd seconded and the motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Jeanne Gill gave the report for March. Total deposits since last meeting \$206.00. Payments made since last meeting \$917.00. The current checking account balance is \$5,015.89 and total CD value is \$14,759.49. Total Certificate (interest paid) \$35.60. Net balance all is \$19,810.98. Davy motioned to approve report, seconded by Brian, motion carried.

**Athletic Director's Corner:** Dana reported the openings for staff and coaches positions available. Nate Lau accepted the math position at the high school replacing Amy Dye. The six bleacher signs stating where to sit are complete. Madison Sign & Lettering are making the school song and code of conduct signs. They will be complete at the end of May. Brian Visger located the summary about the school mascot from the student council to share with the school board. We will host the softball jamboree May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. There will be 40 schools. Charging entry fee of \$3.00 at the Poynette fields behind the high school. This money will be used for creating a JV dugout, improvements made to the JV diamond, or to purchase a batting cage. Not charging at the Arlington field or the downtown field. Capital Conference organizational meeting is May 10<sup>th</sup> at Lakeside Lutheran. All head coaches must attend. The tri-op for hockey was approved by WIAA. The teams will be DeForest, Poynette, and Lodi. This next fall the JV football team will have a home football game against the South Eastern Home School Team out of Milwaukee. Appreciation was made from the girls' basketball team for the coach bus for the regional game.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- Gym Seating Signs: Addressed in the AD corner
- Press Box: Brian brought in the rough draft. It is a two-story structure. The first floor is 610 square feet and the second floor is 498 square feet. Discussed changes of room occupancy and size. Everything is as maintenance free as possible. Coaches will look at and give feed back to Brian. Todd, Brian, Dana and Craig will talk to Barb Wolfe to get on the

agenda for the May 8<sup>th</sup> school board meeting. One reading might be enough or we will have to get on the May 22<sup>nd</sup> agenda. They want to start building in June. August 25<sup>th</sup> is the first football game. Many questions about the location of the scoreboard location. Possibility for a new scoreboard costing approximately \$4800.00 hopefully with help from the Pepsi fund money and donation from Research Products. The old scoreboard can be used at the multi-use fields on Park street

- Scholarships: Todd gave Jeanne the applications to look over and pass on to Paul to then discuss with Craig and Dana to make the decisions.
- Sportsmanship and School Song Signs: Addressed in the AD Corner
- Mascot Issues: Brian wrote letter stating that we should decide on a mascot so that the students can have one and move on. Motion made to present letter to the school board by Cheryl R., seconded by Joann. Motion carried.

- Any Other Old Business: The pancake breakfast has a profit of \$971.40. Coach Cross has not let us know what she would like. We discussed putting it in writing that 80% of the net proceeds goes to the organization that runs it. Motion for this to be allowed by Jean, seconded by Paul. Motion carried.
